Are you interested in designing, fabricating, assembling, testing and competing in small combat and task oriented robots? Are you interested in a program that is business orientated with budgeting, safety protocols as well as marketing? Good news, we have an opening! Season starts September 2021 and possibly extend to end of May 2022.

The ideal candidate would have experience with the FRC program and/or experience fabricating/engineering or teaching. Details: Computer programming, CAD designing, technical machining, engineering, business, marketing background is helpful, but not required.

Expectations include practice times, home and away matches, and record keeping.

This is a school year-long co-curricular/extra-curricular position. The team begins meeting in the fall. Build season is from January to March with practices after school and on weekends. Competition events and advancements possibly extends the season to the end of May.
