Roseau Area Arts Association Arts Scholarship

The RAAA Scholarship has been established to support higher education in the arts. One \$750.00 scholarship will be awarded to graduates of any of the listed school districts. Eligible applicants must be pursuing post-secondary education in an arts related field.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. The applicant must be a graduate of one of the listed Roseau County schools.
- 2. Graduates of the listed Roseau County schools currently enrolled in an arts program at a qualifying post-secondary institution are eligible to apply; however, current high school seniors will receive first consideration.
- 3. The applicant must indicate his/her intention to pursue post-secondary education in an arts related field.
- 4. Financial need may be considered in awarding the scholarship, but it is not a primary criteria for eligibility.
- 5. Previous scholarship recipients may apply in subsequent years; however, priority will be given to new applicants. The maximum number of RAAA scholarships per individual will be two.

Application Process:

- 1. Complete the attached application form.
- 2. Provide a transcript of grades and attendance for grades 9-12. Applicants currently enrolled in a post-secondary program should provide a copy of their most recent transcript.
- 3. Provide a short statement of future plans and goals: describe your commitment to the arts, how you hope to use your arts education to enrich your own life, and how you might use your education to benefit your community.
- 4. Provide a personal letter of recommendation from a non-family member detailing the qualities and experiences that make you a deserving recipient of this art scholarship.

Selection and Award:

- 1. High School Guidance counselors will be notified of the selected recipients.
- 2. Recipients will be recognized at the senior awards program.
- 3. Scholarship awards will be publicized in local media.
- 4. Scholarship funds will be issued to the student upon receipt of a transcript of the recipient's first semester grades and a tuition bill or class schedule for the next semester that verifies the recipient is continuing in an arts related field of education.
- 5. The required documents should be mailed to Jean Johnson- RAAA Treasurer, 1008 Main Ave. South, Roseau MN, 56751. If a selected recipient fails to meet the criteria for scholarship payout, the scholarship funds may be awarded to an alternate qualified applicant at the discretion of the RAAA board of directors.
