ROSEAU COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE:

Roseau County 4-H will award up to four members each year a scholarship of \$250 each. This scholarship is to provide financial support to Roseau County 4-H members who have a desire to continue their educational training after their senior year and have been contributing members of the Roseau County 4-H program for a minimum of 1 full 4-H year.

DETAILS:

- 1. The scholarships are being presented by the Roseau County 4-H Leaders Council from funds raised by its membership.
- 2. The scholarships will be presented at graduation ceremonies or awards programs in the schools represented.
- 3. The scholarships will be issued after the successful completion of <u>one semester</u> of higher education.
- 4. The scholarship review committee will include selected adult volunteers who make up the Roseau County 4-H Executive committee or other adult volunteers selected by the Local Extension Educators. They will go over the applications and make the selections using a ranking system. Names of the applicants will not be available to the review committee, only their application information. Committee members cannot be parents of the applicants. In the event there is a parent on the executive committee, a new volunteer will be designated by the Extension Educator.
- 5. Applications are available on the Roseau County 4-H website, from the UMN Extension/4-H Office, Roseau County or your school counselor.

INSTRUCTIONS & REQUIREMENTS:

Applications must be in the county UMN Extension/4-H office, Roseau County by **April 15** of the current year.

Applicants need to submit:

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Two letters of recommendation. One letter <u>must be</u> from a 4-H leader or 4-H Screened Volunteer who you have worked with and can not be a parent.
- 3. A written statement by the applicant on, "How will you apply the four H's in your life moving forward?"
