You may qualify for consideration of the scholarship if you will be attending a 4 year, or a 2 year, or a vocational/technical post secondary program. The scholarship will be awarded after submission of a grade report of successful completion of first semester classes. Successful completion means a minimum of "C" average in **each class**, and you must successfully complete a **minimum of 12 credits** in the semester.

If you are unable to successfully complete the requirements for this scholarship during first semester, you may pursue meeting the requirements second semester and receive the scholarship by submitting a grade report of successful completion at the end of second semester.

- 1) Scholastic Achievement: Submit a transcript for your senior year of high school attendance.
- 2) List extracurricular activities that you participated in and awards, if any, that you received during your high school years.
- 3) List and describe any leadership positions you held during your high school years.
- 4) List all community service performed during your high school years. (i.e.) Support to veterans organizations, nursing home, church, volunteerism, etc.
- 5) Work experience: List and describe all jobs you have held throughout your high school years.
- 6) Veterans affiliation: List all family members (and their relationship to you) who **have** or **are** serving in the United States military.
- 7) Are you considering serving in the military?      Why? or Why not?
- 8) How do you feel that you can best serve your country?
- 9) What post-secondary school do you plan to attend?
- 10) Describe how your chosen career will benefit and serve veterans and/or their families.
