Badger Community School is seeking a full time instrumental music, elementary classroom music, and Elementary Title I teacher for the 2025-2026 academic year. The qualified applicant will be responsible for teaching a mix of Elementary Classroom Music classes, individual instrumental lessons to beginning Elementary Band students, and working with elementary students in all grades who receive Title I services. The music portion of the position is .5 FTE and the Title I portion of the position is .5 FTE. This position has the support of a dedicated staff which is a vibrant mix of veteran and younger educators focused on serving the needs of students and each other.

The Badger School District Music Department is a source of pride for the Badger Community. The Badger High School Concert Band and Concert Choir compete annually in the Minnesota State High School League Music contests, consistently earning top rankings at the events. The high school music department collaborates with the high school drama department to present a bi-annual "Music Revue" production featuring the acting and musical talents of our high school artists. The elementary music department presents two concerts a year, which has traditionally included a multi grade level musical production. The artistic endeavors of the Badger Music Department are strongly supported by school staff, parents, school administration, school board, and the community at large!

Badger is a stable smaller school near the northern border of greater Minnesota located on Minnesota State Highway 11. It does not take too much imagination to come up with four seasons of fun with the neighboring forest areas, inviting rivers, wetlands, recreational trails and golf courses in close proximity to Badger. Also, Badger is located less than an hour drive to Lake of the Woods for boating, camping and some of the best year-round fishing in the state.

Pay and Benefits: Starting pay will be no less than \$48,239 and may be up to \$77,116 based on education and experience along with a comprehensive benefit package including the following:

- School District contribution towards the premium cost of enrollment in the school district's group health and hospitalization plan - \$6,375 annually for single coverage, \$11,650 annually for family coverage;
- School district contribution of \$70 per month to eligible employee's individual Health Savings Account;
- School District will match up to \$1,200 in contributions to a 403B retirement plan;
- School District contribution of \$30 per month towards the premium cost of enrollment in the school district's single dental insurance plan or \$70 per month towards the premium cost of enrollment in the school district's family dental plan;
- Teachers receive 16 PTO days annually. Days can be carried over from year to year, accruing to a maximum of 135 days.

Licensure: Valid Minnesota K-12 Instrumental and Classroom Music teaching license and/or K-6 Elementary Education teaching license or ability to obtain such licensures by August 25, 2025.

Candidates with training, degrees or licenses in other related content areas are also welcome to apply. Badger School is willing to explore Tier 1, Tier 2 or an Out of Field Permission if necessary within accordance of PELSB guidelines and timelines.

Other income opportunities may also include co-curricular advising, directing or coaching athletics; however, not required.
